## • LIVE AUCTION PROCEDURES •

*You will receive your auction paddle at registration. Please do not loan your paddle to anyone for you are responsible for all sales recorded with that number.*

*The auctioneer will show each piece of art work and will provide a starting bid. Raise your paddle to place a bid. Once the auctioneer has declared the winner, that person has a legal contract to purchase the item. Payment will be accepted in the form of cash, check and VISA/MasterCard. Please have appropriate identification. All purchases are final and must be paid for the same evening as the auction. All items must be removed on the evening of April 25, 2009, unless a prior arrangement has been made.*
