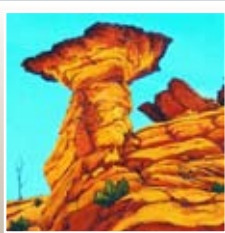

With instruction from his father, Royden began painting at age fourteen. He had been introduced to (and immediately fell in love with) the red rock and barren desert landscape of Utah a few years earlier. From those beginnings, he pursued a career as an artist, eventually obtaining a BFA and a MFA, from BYU. His inspiration primarily comes from the desert landscape of the southwest U.S. and the hand built structures of its indigenous people. Royden paints landscapes that sometimes are not considered beautiful, usually labeled "badlands." The subject matter may not be immediately appealing but he is drawn to it. It requires a unique outlook to be enjoyed. He believes the way that he paints and interprets this landscape allows other people to discover its rarified beauty. During the past few years, Royden's artistic output has also included prose and poetry. Some of the literary work accompanied by his sketches has been published in the book *Desert Dawn*.

Originally from England, Jill moved to Austin, TX in 2002. Following a twelve-year career as a curatorial research assistant at the National Portrait Gallery in London, she now paints full-time. Believing that one should "grow where one is planted," she has been fast to establish herself in Texas where she has become well known for her renderings of the Texas Hill Country and of the Big Bend Desert region. Further painting trips to Colorado, California, Wyoming, Idaho, Arizona and Utah have extended her knowledge of and passion for the Western landscape. She has earned many awards for her work in national juried shows; in 2008, she won the Artists Choice Award at Telluride Plein Air Festival, San Luis Obispo, the Sedona Painting Festival and at Easton.
